Cookie Jar Game

(Works best 4/4 or 2/4 beat meter songs)

You need:

An empty snack jar or cleaned out oatmeal tub.

A sheet of foam core- (this gives deminsion to cookies)

Tape, glue, scissors,

2 sheets paper: colored or white

Paper or plastic plate.

Copy and cut out cookies and lables. Glue or tape a piece of trimmed paper around tub; then attach label to front. Cut a piece of paper to match top of lid and glue on. Cut out plate lable ad glue in the middle of plate. Cut out cookies and glue one side of each cookie to foam core and cut out. Glue on the remaining side of each cookie. Place cookies into cookie jar and put on lid.

To Play: tell the children that we need to share (the gospel with others and or to love others). We are going to pass this cookie jar to the music and when it stops, whoever has the cookie jar is going to pick out a cookie and put it on this plate. Then when we sing our song we are going to share actions with a partner. Have pianist to play part of a song then stop. The child holding the Cookie Jar picks out a cookie, and puts it on the sharing plate. Bear testimony and the end of the game that we feel happy and receive blessings when we are willing to share!

Gingerbread Men: Clap twice then pat your partners hands twice - repeat for song

Chocolate Chip: Link elbows and march in place

Blue Sugar Cookie: Pat your knees twice pat your partners hand twice.

White Sugar Cookie: Clap twice, pat partner's right hands twice, clap twice, pat partner's left hands twice.

<u>Fortune Cookie:</u> You and partner stand back to back, with hands flat, swing arms back so the you pat your partners hands to the music.

Cookie With Bite: You didn't share: Everyone sing with their eyes closed!







Plate label- cut out and glue to a paper plate.
