



Prepare the game board by coloring and laminating it.

















Fill in the blank cards, if you wish. Laminate and cut out the cards and hearts.

To play: The idea of this game is to help children find appropriate solutions to problems. Place the cards face down in a pile beside the game board. Use 1 die to determine moves. Place a marker for each person on start. Every time a player lands on a frown, he must go back 1 space. When a player lands on a heart, he takes a card from the top of the pile and must answer the question. If he gives an appropriate solution, he receives a heart. To win, a player must get to the happy home with the most hearts.
