

“In My Stocking”

Song and Activity

Find and download the sheet music and MP3 accompaniment track under the Seasonal tab, then click on the choral drop down.



This is a quick and easy song to learn and you can assign items or let the children choose what items to draw then color in their stocking. You can have eight different items and a candy cane for the song. If there are more than eight children, make a list together then have the children each choose one of the items on the list.

Use the hand out below before you teach the song.

1. Just copy one of the hand outs below for each child. After they color, cut out the stockings. You may use card stock or heavy copy paper
2. Hot glue a tongue depressor or large craft stick to the back to make it easier to hold up.

Always have the children write their name on the back!

Teach the song using the poster visual aids 1-4. Decide your order of items to sing about and have the children line up in order. Use the accompaniment track if you don't have a pianist and sing naming those items and hold up the stockings that match as you sing the song.
