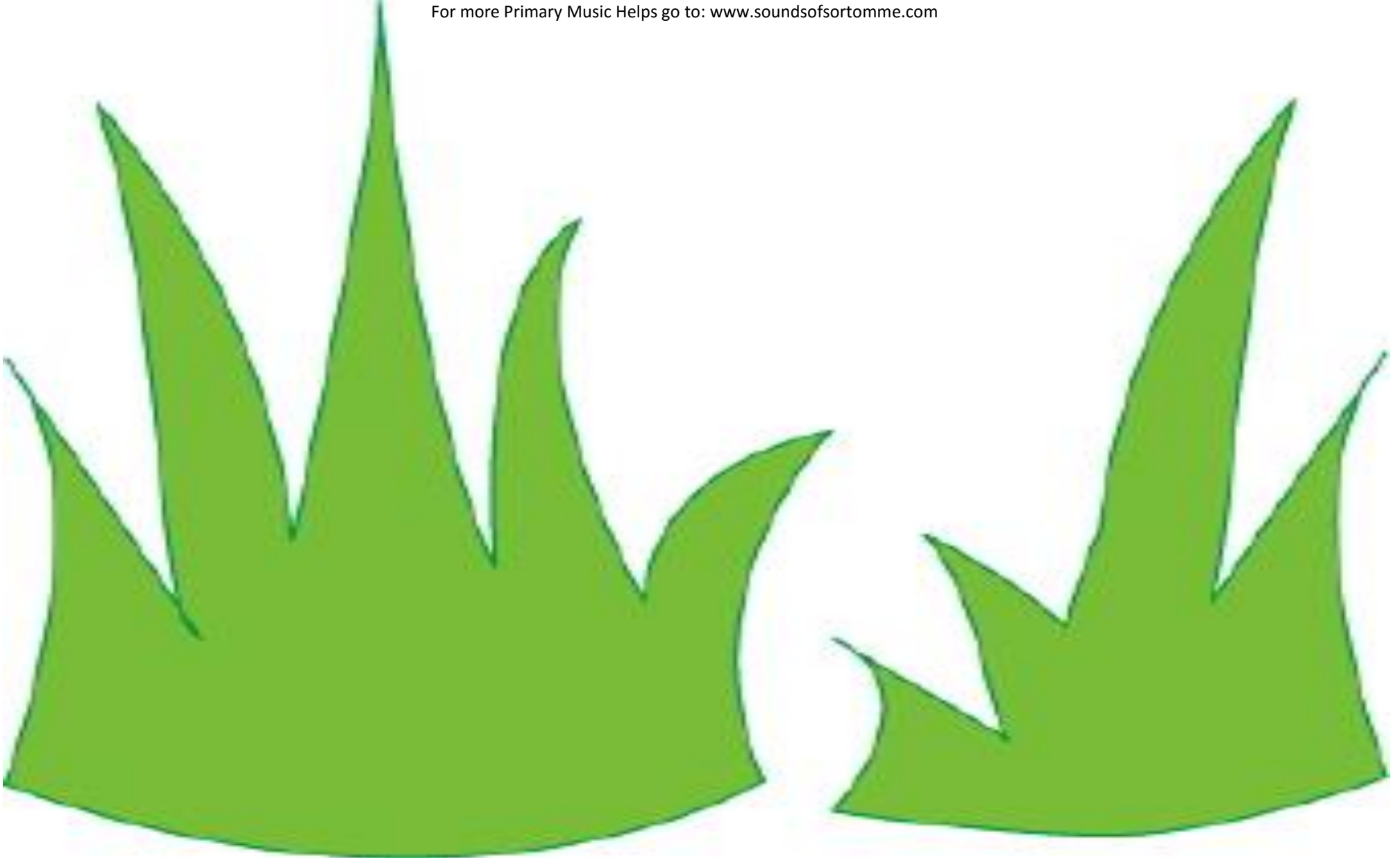


Tulip Song Garden Tulip Song Garden and tulips. Copy (on card stock or heavy paper- laminate or cover with contact paper (for durability). Cut out stems and stems of the flowers. Glue to a poster or foam board. (For durability you can cover poster with clear contact paper.) OR use on a magnetic board or chalk board with tape, magnets or sticky tack. Cut out flowers and laminate or cover with contact paper. Write song names on slips of paper or sticky notes and attach to the backs of tulips. (You can use the poster again and again with different songs.) Use to choose songs or review songs or even encourage children to sing out by putting the tulip on the stems after the song is sung well.

As children take turns picking the songs and they are sung, you place the tulips chosen on the stems and make the garden grow.
