



Jinglers





(materials)



Simple to make and use these rhythm instruments are great for small and large hands alike!

You need for each Jingler

2 Jingle bells: medium or large

Hot glue and glue gun

Washi style tape or colored electric tape (different colors if desired)

1 straight 12" length of floral or craft wire

Wire cutter

2 jumbo craft sticks

To make:

Cut 12" wire in half with wire cutters

Put on two bells (3 or 4 if using small bells) and twist wire several times to secure bells.


Hot glue wire on one crat stick.


When dry hot glue remaining stick over wire as shown.

Wrap decorative or colored electrical tape around the

craft stick. Now the Jingler is ready!

(Glue wired bells to craft stick, glue on 2nd stick.)











To use:

Use as an incentive to sing well.

After they sing a song well, hand out Jinglers (if using for a large group, divide Jinglers into gift bags and hand out to teachers distribute them.

Instruct children to shake the Jinglers to the beat of the next song.

When finished, have the teachers collect the Jinglers in the bags and collect bags form teachers.
