

Download and print out Fishing Game (found under Primary Music helps at www.soundsofsortomme.com) and prepare fish and pole as directed. Also use the blue (cloth or poster board, or pool) pond or to scatter the fish in. Print and cut out as many ice blocks as needed place around the pond (secure with masking tape) or tape to the sides of the pool. Have a hat (or ear muffs) and coat (and scarf if desired) and mittens or gloves for the fisherman to put on the catch the fish.

Explain that when the lakes are frozen in some places fisherman cut out blocks of ice and make a hole in the ice to fish. They have to wear heavy clothes while they are out on the ice. Heavenly Father gave us seasons and each one brings different weather. Since its winter time we can go ice fishing. Choose children to fish, quickly help them put on the coat, gloves, and hat or earmuffs to fish. (Explain we don't want to get cold so we need to bundle up quickly) Follow directions on the back of each fish (written on a sticky note.) Ideas below.

Use to review new songs you are learning by assigning the fish (on back with a sticky note) a line of the song or a verse or the chorus. Make sure to make a list for yourself and the pianist.

You may also use to pick songs or even to assign how you will sing the song. (See Primary Music Helps: Boy/ Girl Singing Signs, Clappers, Jinglers, Animal Singing Signs, Oatmeal Drums, Singing Signs and Rhythm and Ribbon Sticks.) Have Fun!
