



Leap Frog Game



Copy 2 (or 3 if you have a large group) of each image on heavy paper or card stock. Cut out two frogs. Laminate images for durability or use sheet protectors on each image (just trim off the side with 3 holes). Copy 12 lily pad cards, and small images attaching an image on the back of each. These will be the selection cards to determine where the frogs move and the song to be sung. Tape frogs on a Clear Cup.

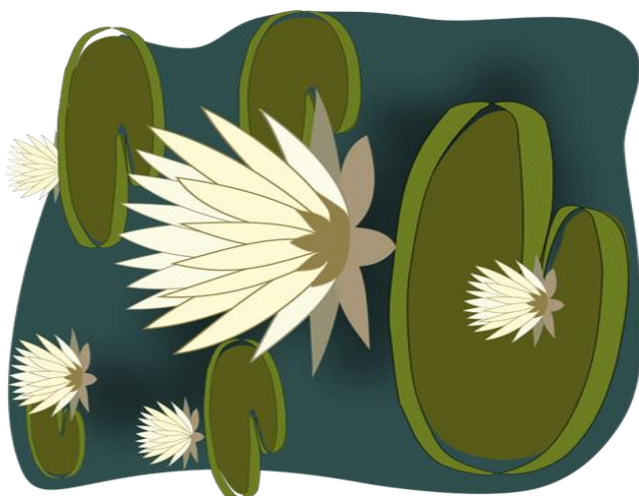
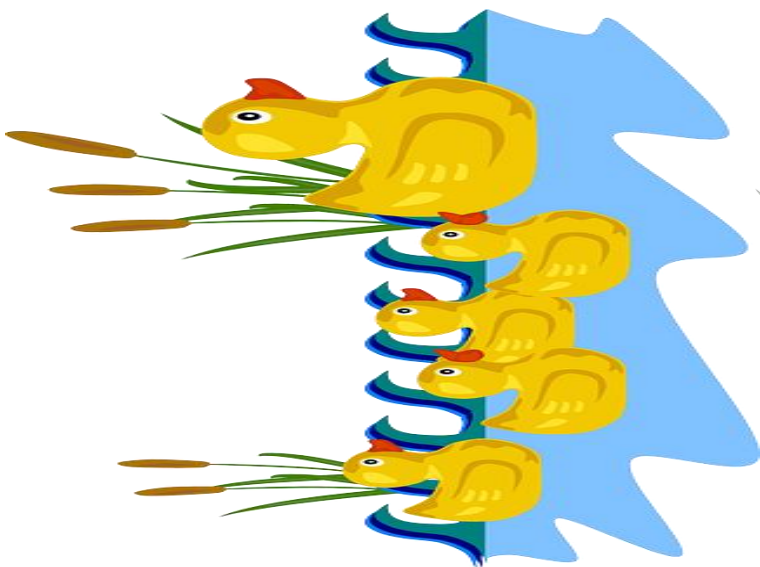
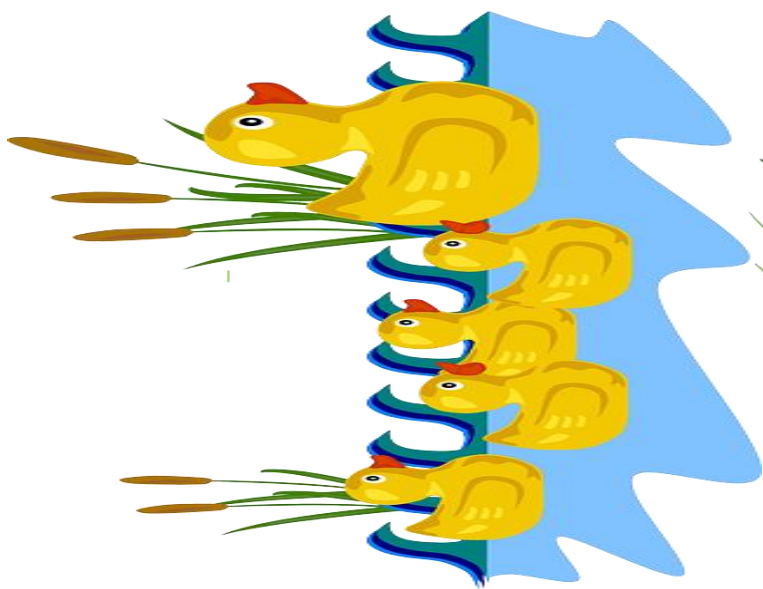
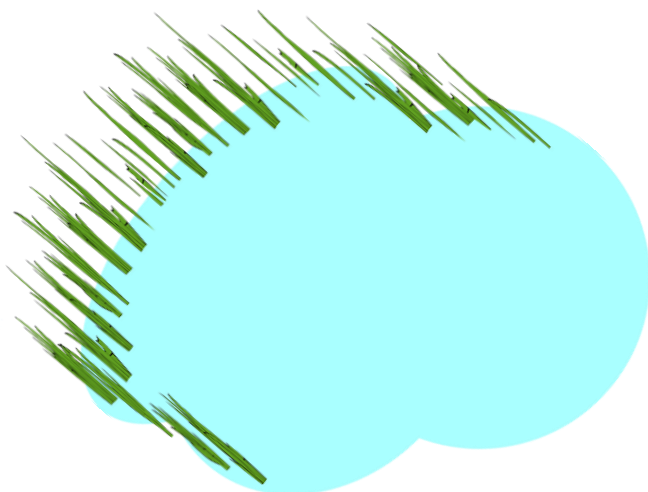
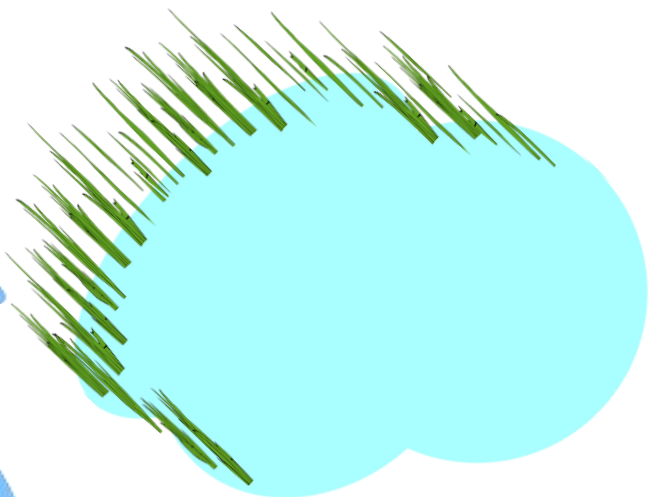
Choose a phrase of a song or a song (if reviewing several for each image. (Use one of the charts below.)

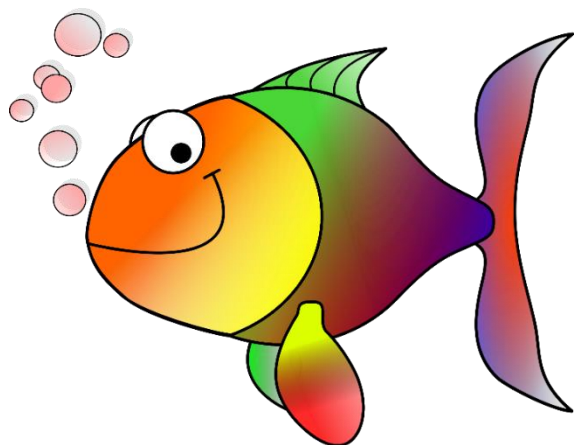
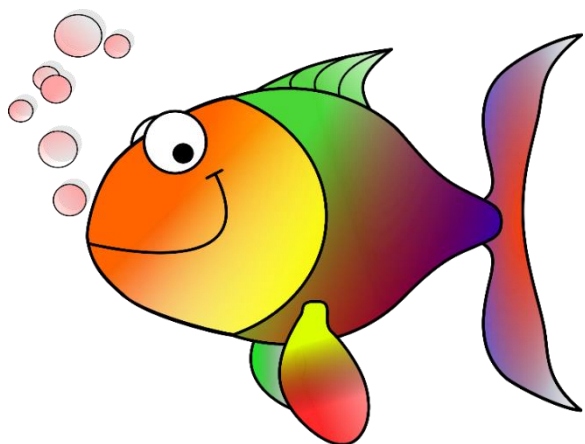
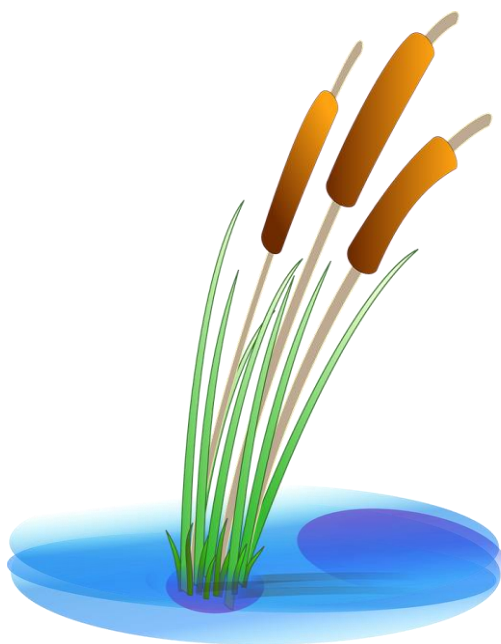
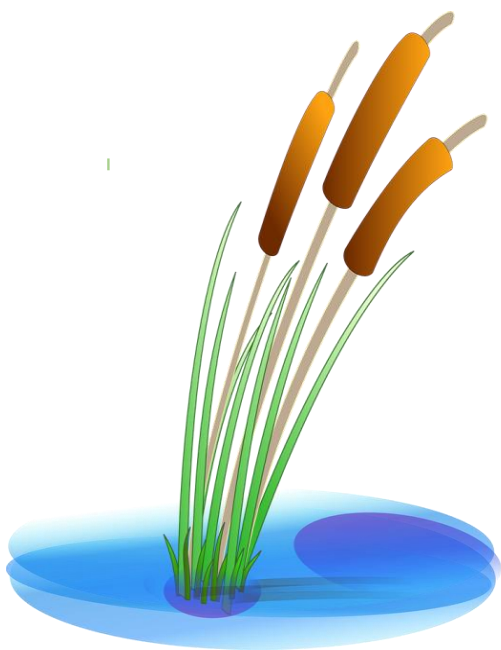
Arrange one set of images in a circle either on the floor or on a wall, chalk or magnetic board.

Divide children into two groups. Taking turns, choose a child from each group. Each child selects a lily pad, displays the image and moves their frog to that image. Sing the phrase or song with actions listed. The next child selects a lily pad, reveals the image and moves their frog to that image and the song or phrase is sung.

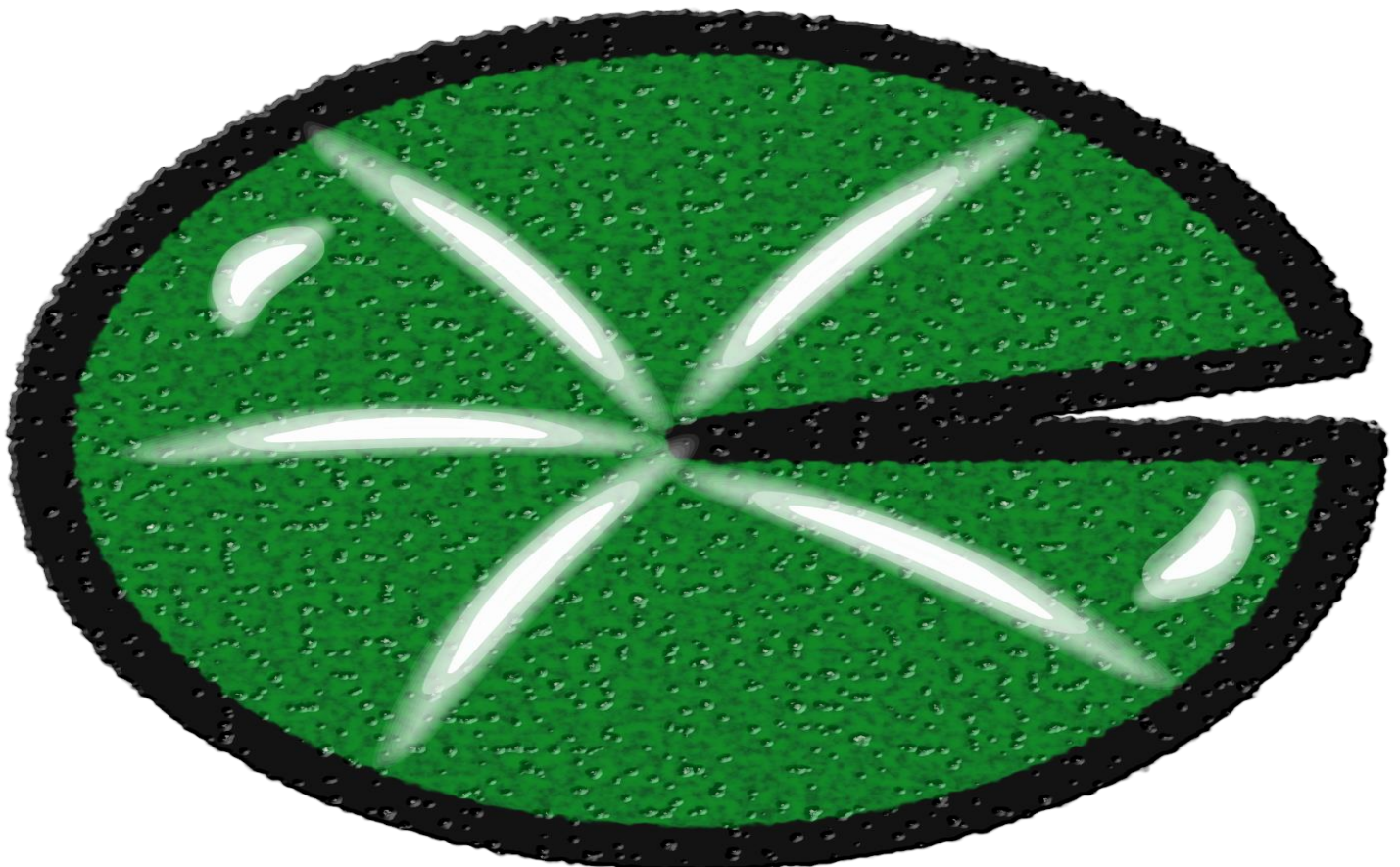
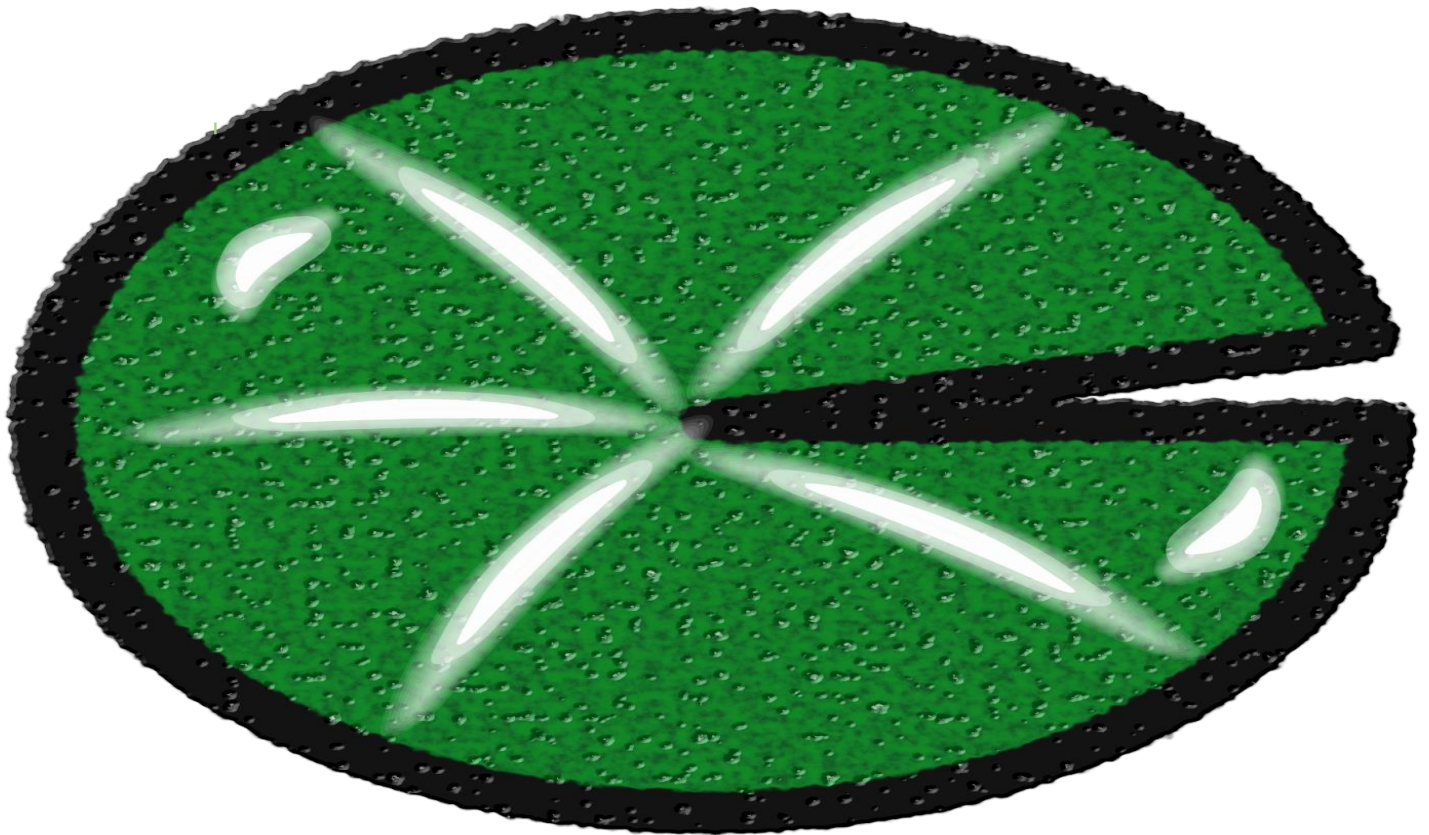
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Copy and cut out 14- glue the small images to the back of each.



List the song or phrase and follow the actions listed (or create your own.)

Ducks _____ Action- sing with hands making a duck beak movement as you sing. Or Flap elbows like a duck.

Pond _____ Action- shoo away the bugs that are in the air. Or Clap hands to rhythm(catching the bugs.

Cat tails _____ Action-Wave arms as if the cattails were blowing in the breeze.

Lilypads _____ Action- Sing and stand up on toes then down again to the beat of the music. Or (if there is room) Tip toe around to creep up on the frog.

Fish _____ Action- Sing Use your arms with a swimming motion as if in the water. Or Put hands together and move them like a fish swims.

WaterLily _____ Action-Sing softly so as not to scare the frog. Or With your finger draw circular water ripples in the air.

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
